Continuing Education Class Announcements/Protocol

At every classroom or speech/seminar each instructor or Provider Designated Person or Provider on-site representative shall be required, prior to the commencement of instruction, to read the following statements:

One credit is 50 minutes of instruction with no more than 10 minutes for a break. Fractional credits will not be awarded. Registration, coffee and lunch breaks, or social hours do not qualify for CE credit.

A student that arrives 10 or more minutes late or departs early will not receive CE credit.

All classroom courses must have attendance verified through a sign-in/sign-out sheet with a door monitor. Only students meeting minimum attendance requirements may receive Certificates of Completion.

Students must provide their name, address, license number (not SSN), time-in and time out. Reminders are given by the instructor to sign the attendance forms.

Providers must give Certificates of Completion to all individuals who complete the requirements of a CE course.

Providers should make students aware that licensees cannot receive CE credit for both a self-study (examination) course and a classroom course based on the same published materials.

Providers should make students aware that licensees are not allowed to receive or carry over credit for the same course in the same review period.

No conduct of insurance or other business by any means whatsoever or the reading of newspapers or publications unrelated to the courses may occur during the instructional period. Use of electronic devices is determined by the education provider. All electronic device ringers or sound effects should be turned off at the start of class. Emails, voice messages, etc. may be checked during breaks or lunch.

To facilitate learning, all students taking the course must be attentive and respectful to instructors and fellow students. ACTIVE participation is required.

Representatives of PSI and members of DIFS and/or its designees, may audit classroom courses, course materials, instructors' presentations and course records. Audits will be conducted in a manner that will minimize disruptions.

New York Mandatory Class Announcements

At every classroom or speech/seminar each instructor or Provider Designated Person or Provider on-site representative shall be required, *prior* to the commencement of instruction, to read the following statements:

a) Display of Approval Documents

"Provider, Affiliate, Course and Instructor Approval Documents issued by the New York State Department of Financial Services are available for viewing by each attendee. The course approval document lists the specific classes of license to which the course applies. All attendees should check the approval document to ensure their class of license is so noted. Please take note that the Course Approval number is a necessary element for the renewal of your license".

b) Conduct of Insurance or Other Business during the Instructional Period

"No conduct of insurance or other business by any means whatsoever or the reading of newspapers or publications unrelated to the course may occur during the instructional period. All pagers and cell phones must be set so as to not disturb the class during class instruction".

c) Attendance Policy

"The NYS Department of Financial Services requires licensees to be in attendance for 100 percent of the approved class hours. Accordingly, licensees arriving late to class or returning late from meal breaks or scheduled breaks may be denied course credit. Providers are required to establish an attendance policy and maintain attendance records. Failure to enforce attendance rules or to maintain proper attendance records could result in disciplinary action against the Provider. Therefore, adherence to the Provider's attendance requirements is mandatory."

d) Course Completion Documents

"A Course Completion Document will be issued to each attendee who satisfies the Provider's attendance requirements and completes this course. In addition to the course approval number and applicable class of license, the Course Completion Document shows the number of credits you have received for completing this class. This document is your evidence that you successfully completed the course and should be retained in your personal records for five (5) years. Completing the CE requirement does not constitute a renewal of your insurance license. When it is time to renew your license you will be notified by the Department and you will be responsible for completing a renewal application in the manner set forth by the Department. You will need the Course Completion Document to complete your license renewal application and, in the event of a Department audit, you will be asked to produce your Course Completion Document(s).

Oklahoma Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association

History & Purpose

The Oklahoma Life & Health Insurance Guaranty Association is a statutory entity created in 1981 when the Oklahoma legislature enacted the Oklahoma Guaranty Association Act. The guaranty association is composed of all insurers licensed to sell life insurance, accident and health insurance, and individual annuities in the state of Oklahoma. In the event that a member insurer is found to be insolvent and is ordered to be liquidated by a court, the Guaranty Association Act enables the guaranty association to provide protection (up to the limits spelled out in the Act) to Oklahoma residents who are holders of life and health insurance policies and individual annuities with the insolvent insurer.

Coverage Limitations

The Guarantee Association Act established limits on benefits as follows:

- a. The Association cannot pay more than the insurance company would owe under a contract or policy
- b. \$100,000 maximum cash surrender value
- c. \$300,000 maximum for life or health insurance benefits or for the present value of an annuity contract, regardless of the number of policies in effect with the same company or the difference types of coverage.

Exclusions

Restrictions on Use

The law prohibits insurance agents and companies from using the Oklahoma guaranty association in any advertising. The guaranty association is not and should not be a substitute for your prudent selection of an insurance company that is well managed and financially stable. Agents are prohibited by statute from using this Web site or the existence of the guaranty association as an inducement to purchase insurance.

Advertising Prohibition Policy

Section 2043 Advertising prohibited--Exemptions--Preparation of summary document Disclaimer--Notice of noncoverage (A) No person, including an insurer, agent or affiliate of an insurer shall make, publish, disseminate, circulate or place before the public, or cause directly or indirectly to be made, published, disseminated, circulated or placed before the public, in any newspaper, magazine or other publication, or in the form of a notice, circular, pamphlet, letter or poster, or over any radio station or television station, or in any other way, any advertisement, announcement or statement which uses the existence of the Oklahoma Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association of this state for the purpose of sales, solicitation or inducement to purchase any form of insurance covered by the Oklahoma Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association Act. Provided, however, that this Section shall not apply to the Oklahoma Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association or any other entity which does not sell or solicit insurance.

In accordance with recently adopted changes to South Carolina Code of Regulations 69.50 VI. (D), all Continuing Education (CE) providers or instructors are required to provide a copy of this reminder notice to each attendee of a classroom course. The Regulation also requires all <u>correspondence</u> course providers to include this notice in all continuing education course material (12 pt. Font Bold). Note: course providers must maintain in their records for at least three years certification that a copy of this notice was distributed to each producer subscribing to their respective course.

- Effective May 27, 2022, producers may now apply for CE exemption if you are 65 years of age or older <u>AND</u> have 25 or more years of licensure. The online application is available on our website on the CE page.
- Effective January 1, 2017, a valid personal and/or business email address is required by law. Please visit NIPR (https://pdb.nipr.com/my-nipr/frontend/identify-licensee) to update your email address. The Department will no longer be mailing hard copy renewal notices to licensees.
- Effective January 2011, the deadline for biennially complying with continuing education and license renewal is the last day of the producer's month of birth. Producers born in an odd numbered year must comply by the last day of the birth month in an odd numbered year. Producers born in an even numbered year must comply by the last day of the birth month in an even numbered year.
- The CE hours must be completed prior to renewing the license on NIPR. You should allow at minimum 72 hours for your CE status to be updated before you will be able to renew your license. If you wait until the last day of your birth month to complete your CE, you will not be able to renew on time and will incur a late renewal penalty.
- Producers must complete 24 hours of continuing education including a minimum of 3 hours of Ethics by the deadline before they can renew the license online at NIPR (www.nipr.com).
- Multi-line (property and casualty and life, accident and health) producers must complete 24 hours of CE credits. A minimum of 8 credit hours must be completed in each line of authority and a minimum of 3 credit hours of Ethics.
- Producers with <u>reduced compliance requirements</u> (15 hours) must complete 12 hours in the line of authority held and 3 hours of Ethics. Multi-line producers with <u>reduced compliance requirements</u> (15 hours) must complete 6 hours in each line of authority and 3 hours of ethics. Failure to comply by the last day of the producer's birth month will result in the license being expired. The law allowing reduced CE compliance was repealed January 1, 2010. This Section applies only to those producers who were granted a reduced CE compliance prior to January 1, 2010.
- Up to 18 CE hours in excess of the CE compliance period may be carried over and applied to the next compliance period; Ethics hours will not carryover.
- An individual who arrives after the start of a CE class or leaves before the class is over will not receive credit for the continuing education classroom session, regardless of the number of hours completed during the class session. Instructors may deny credit to anyone who is inattentive (reading the newspaper, talking, texting, using cell phone, etc.).
